
'STAMPS OF GREAT BRITAIN USED IN MALTA 1857 - 1884'

This **new MSC book** (**Study Paper #60**) is the definitive work on GB stamps used in Malta. At 116 pages it is by far the most detailed and comprehensive study of these stamps.

As well as studying the stamps themselves this book considers how these stamps were used, and cancelled.

Chapter 2: considers their early use before the stamps were officially introduced into Malta, especially on mail emanating from the Crimea.

Chapter 3: relates the official process for their introduction to Malta.

Chapter 4: considers the 'M' cancels, along with other datestamps often used in conjunction with it and then gives a reference listing of all known usage.

Chapter 5: takes the same approach for the 'A25' cancel. The 1d red plates are given relative scarcity ratings, and details of known blocks are listed.

Chapter 6: catalogues and describes the use of British Postal Stationery during this period.

Chapter 7: describes the postal rates from Malta to various destinations including the postal arrangements with the receiving countries, such as accountancy marks. Forces concessionary rates are described, as are ship letter rates.

Chapter 8: describes the special arrangements for the registration of mail.

Chapter 9: describes underpaid and unpaid mail with postage due markings.

Chapter 10: covers arrangements for 'Late letters'.

Chapter 11: Maritime and transit mail.

Chapter 12: Fakes and forgeries. A chapter which provides essential reading for those wishing to avoid buying expensive fakes.

Finally, there are detailed appendices describing the Crimean war period postal rates; Forces privilege rates and Anthony Trollope's report of 1858.

The book is illustrated throughout in colour, with full-size images. For the experienced postal historian, the new enthusiast and anyone with an interest in this period of postal history, this publication is a worthwhile addition to their philatelic literature.
